Marland Fox Hunting Party East of Ponca City, 1927.

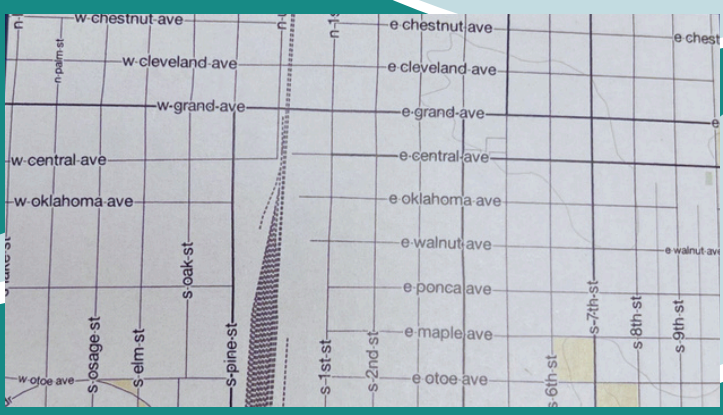
